In 2016, the estimated overall healthcare cost of non-fatal TBI was **\$40.6 BILLION.**<sup>4</sup>

An estimated **2.5 MILLION** caregivers are supporting a person with a TBI.<sup>5</sup>

Older adults with a history of moderate TBI had a **2.3 TIMES** greater risk of developing Alzheimer's.<sup>6</sup>

## **475,000 CHILDREN**

ages 0-14 suffer a TBI each year due to falls and sports related accidents.<sup>7</sup>

Since 2000, more than 485,000 SERVICE MEMBERS have been diagnosed with a TBI.<sup>8</sup>

In 2014, there were approximately **2.5 MILLION TBI-RELATED ER VISITS** in the U.S., including over 812,000 children.<sup>9</sup> **UNINTENTIONAL FALLS** are the leading cause of TBI-related hospitalizations among Americans (*especially adults age 75+ years*) accounting for 30% of TBI-related deaths.<sup>10</sup>
